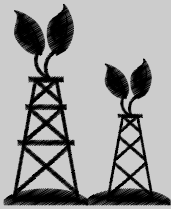
BILLS PASSED

136

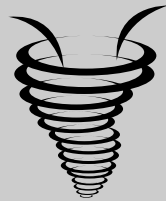
BILLS FAILED

One was about funding a statewide resiliency office.

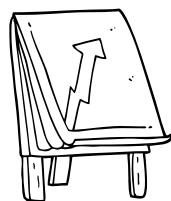
We opposed **one** bill, which would have forced businesses who have certain IT contracts with the state to install invasive monitoring software.

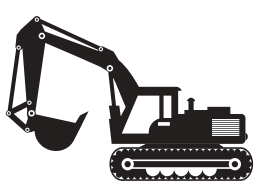
