The 2022 AIA Colorado Design + Honor Awards Recognize the Best Colorado Architecture Projects and Firms

August 31, 2022 (DENVER)— AIA Colorado, the Colorado Chapter of The American Institute of Architects, announces the 2022 Design + Honor Awards recipients, recognizing Colorado architecture firms, projects, and architects for outstanding design and exemplary service.

“Architects are in high demand as people everywhere re-examine their surroundings and raise the expectation of buildings to support health, wellness, and environmental impact,” said AIA Colorado CEO Mike Waldinger, Honorary AIA. “These awards show how firms in Colorado are accepting that challenge in bold and innovative ways.”

Through a jury of respected designers from around the country, submissions were reviewed without identifying the design team and selected based on creatively addressing client needs beautifully, sustainably, and equitably. Jurors can see the boundaries of possibility expand when architects combine new technology, materials, and design thinking.

In addition to the design awards, local architects and firms were recognized with Honor Awards for their breadth of work, leadership in the profession, and contributions to their communities.

“Our members and allies give themselves to others far more than they ever expect to receive in return,” said Waldinger. “This year is no different and showcases people making college more attainable, engaging the public, elevating practice, and leading public policy.”
